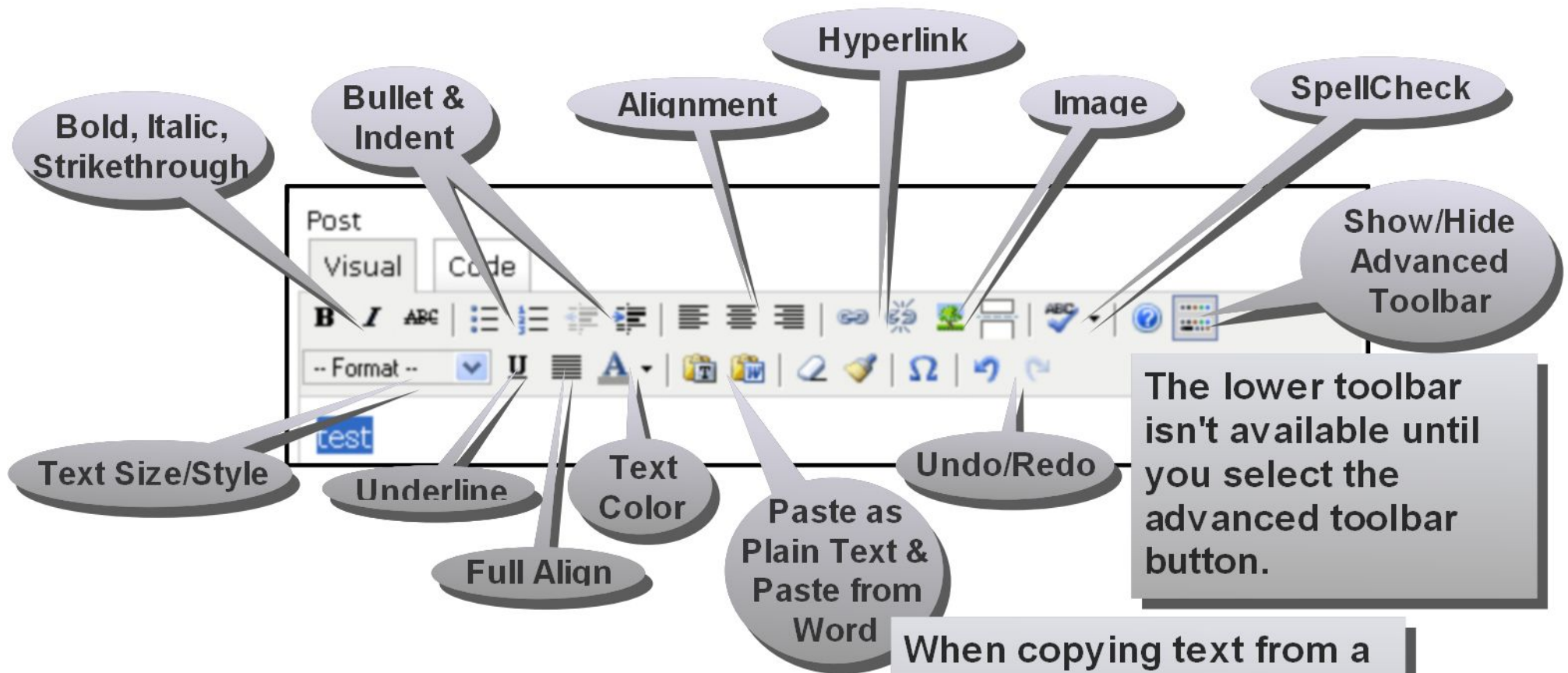

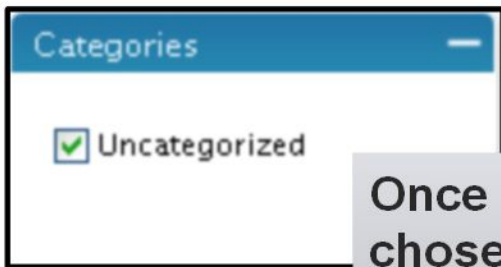

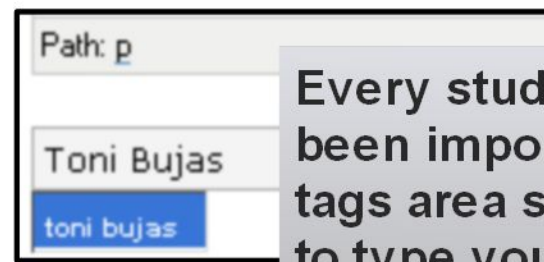

The lower toolbar isn't available until you select the advanced toolbar button.

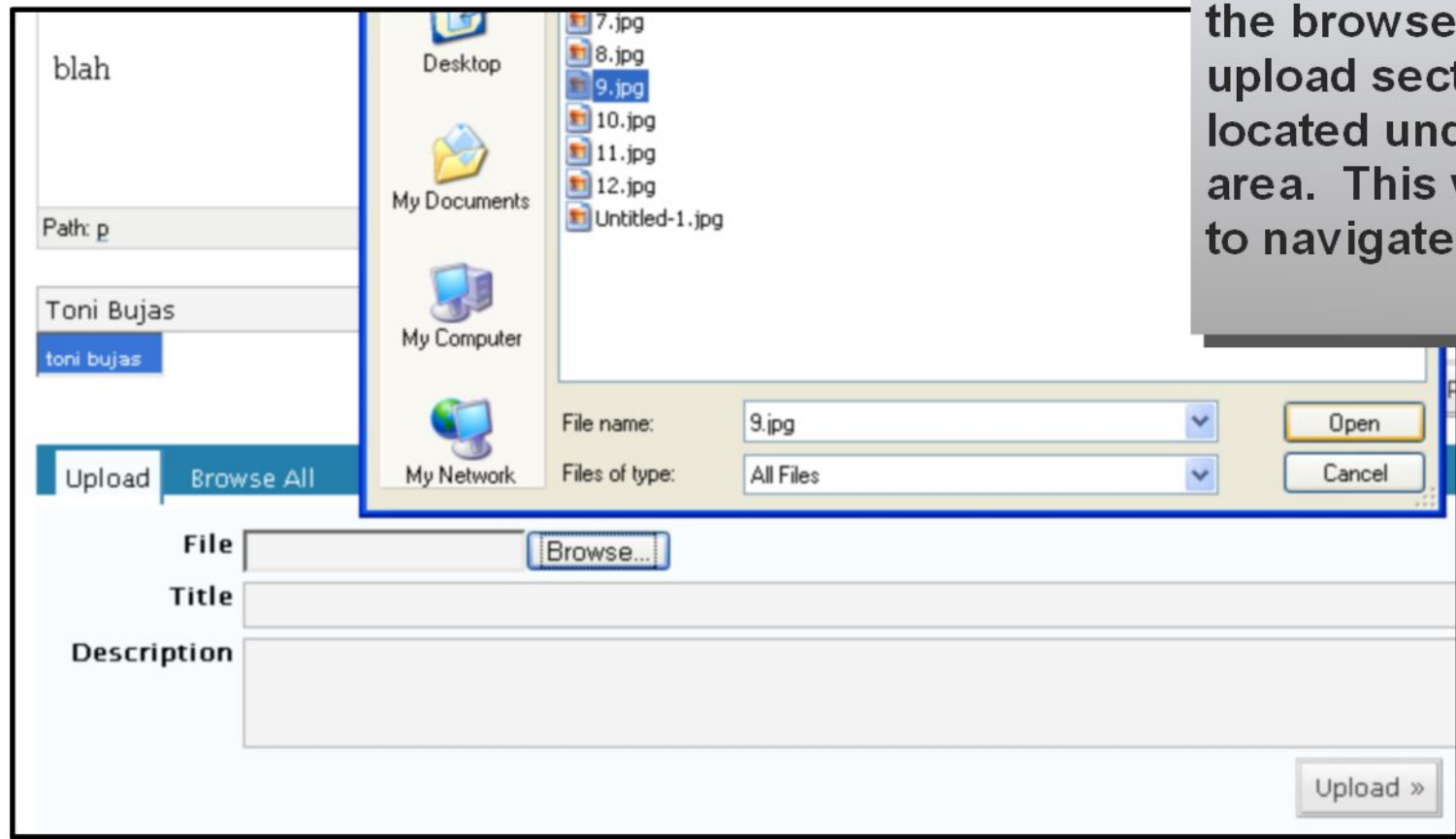
When copying text from a Word Document, always use the 'Paste from word' options so formatting issues don't occur on the page.



Once your topics are chosen, the categories option will have a list to choose from, including your own topic. Put a check mark next to your topic in the list.



Every student's name has been imported into the tags area so as you start to type your name, it should appear below the field and you can click on it to select it.



To upload an image, click the browse button in the upload section that is located under the post area. This will allow you to navigate to your image.

Once the image is in the editor, you can click on it so it shows a blue line around it indicating it has been selected.
